ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- 32-storey office tower located in Toronto's financial district.
- Includes four levels of underground parking (with bicycle racks and change/shower facilities).
- Includes an interior connection to the PATH walkway that connects the building directly to Union Station (Toronto's main transportation hub).
- Engaged as the sustainability consultant, providing sustainability certification, energy modelling, and measurement and verification services.
- WELL v1 CS Silver certified, and achieved LEED Platinum under the LEED v2009 CS rating system.
- Energy modelling was conducted to evaluate building performance for LEED certification and building code compliance.
- Achieved 30 per cent cost savings as compared to the ASHRAE 90.1-2007 baseline.
- Sustainability measures included low-emitting materials, LED lighting, high performance double glass, recycled content and regional materials, and construction waste management (over 95 per cent construction waste was diverted from landfill).
- Low-flow fixtures use 43 per cent less water than LEED baseline flowrates.
- In addition to carpool spaces, the project provides eight charging stations (which
 equates to over 3 per cent of the total parking capacity).
