ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Corporate headquarters for Canon Canada.
- + Security services included the design of an integrated Internet Protocol (IP) video surveillance system as well as electronic card access control, video intercom, and intrusion detection systems throughout the facility.
- + Access control system is designed to control elevator access and turnstiles.
- + Advanced long range readers are installed to control access to underground parking and the main outdoor parking gate.
- + Features integrated video surveillance, access control ,and video intercom systems with various building systems such as a Building Management System (BMS) for efficient start-up and control of air-conditioning and lighting systems.
- + Provided the audiovisual (AV) technology design services for the new Canon headquarters.
- + Included a 120-seat divisible conference space that required flexible presentation, voice lift and control systems, an executive boardroom with integrated audio and video conferencing, and a variety of AV systems for meeting rooms, training rooms, and public spaces.
- + Design of Canon's retail showroom features interactive, architecturally integrated video walls, projection and distributed audio systems.




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
