ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + High-rise office tower (18-storey, Class-AA office space), driven by the principles of collaboration, efficiency, and sustainability, and is a testament to careful integration and low environmental impact.
- + Features private terraces on several office levels, retail at the ground level, accommodates connections to the underground PATH system, and is carefully integrated with the existing heritage façade.
- + Engaged by the developer, Carttera, as the mechanical, electrical, communications, security, and building integration design consultant.
- + Targeting LEED Gold, the mechanical system design adhered to the efficiency, and other goals set out by the developer.
- Achieved Wired Certified Gold.
- + Mechanical design includes an Underfloor Air Distribution (UFAD) system with perimeter radiation heating (optimizes flexibility and comfort for office tenants).
- + Electrical system is 100% redundant, with energy efficient LED lighting throughout the building, and a centralized, low voltage lighting control system.
- + Occupancy and daylight sensors located throughout the office building conserve energy and support tenant comfort.
