ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Contains 125,000 square feet of engaging public space (includes a library, gymnasium, aquatics centre, creation studios, teaching kitchen, and a sensory room with calming light displays).
- + Spent more than a year collaborating with the community to create a facility that would be inclusive of each of Markham's diverse demographic groups and various recreational needs.
- + Engaged as the mechanical consultant, with Footprint as the energy modelling consultant for the project.
- + Aquatics centre includes dehumidification ventilation with heat recovery that provides pool water heating.
- + Change room ventilation system includes exhaust air heat recovery (with make-up heat provided by the building's central heating boiler).
- + Equipped shower drains with heat recovery to pre-heat the domestic hot water system while a pool drain heat recovery system pre-heats the incoming pool water.
- + Air handling systems of the library, multipurpose rooms, and lobby provide demand-controlled ventilation to reduce energy consumption.
- + Provided a commercial kitchen exhaust system (the maker studio includes a point source exhaust system to provide ventilation for the 3D printer).
