



CAMBIE BRIDGE ART INSTALLATION

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Produced by Canada Wild Productions (with technical design, production, and integration by Colours and Shapes), *Uninterrupted* is a cinematic spectacle which transformed the underside of the Cambie Street Bridge into a BC river through audio and visual technology.
- + Projection light mapping was used to project dynamic images on the underside of the bridge.
- + During the summer of 2017, the installation allowed visitors to witness curated video footage of the seasonal sockeye salmon migration in an urban setting.
- + Used the bridge as a three-dimensional canvas.
- + The use of technology in urban art exhibitions (e.g., *Uninterrupted*), or during special events (e.g., the Canadian Parliament Building facade), has become more and more commonplace.
- + Smith + Andersen consulted on this installation, working collaboratively with the electrical contractors to provide electrical technical support and guidance to the team as required.
