ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Phase 1 of the River City development included a 16-storey, two building condominium featuring 350 suites.
- + The first of a five building community of condominiums and townhouses with street-level restaurants, cafes, and boutiques.
- + The two buildings are connected by a three-level bridge walkway providing an indoor link between amenities including a fitness space, two party rooms, and a kitchen, dining, and bar area.
- + A rooftop garden with outdoor pool and BBQ area is accessible from the third floor.
- + The project is a leader in sustainability being the first market development on Toronto's West Don Lands Flood Protection Landform.
- + Required goals for the project included achieving LEED Gold, with a minimum net energy savings of 40 per cent over the Model National Energy Code for Buildings.
- + The design features a four-pipe fan coil unit, with chilled and heated water plant located in the penthouse mechanical rooms.
- + The four-pipe system permits residents to select cooling or heating on demand, providing increased thermal comfort year-round. This eliminates the heating-to-cooling change over service interruption associated with a traditional two-pipe fan coil system.


