ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Tim Hortons created a unique, on-brand workplace in the former trading floor and offices of the Toronto Stock Exchange in the Exchange Tower.
- + Two-level head office in the Central Business District embraces modern design elements while also featuring the company's Canadian roots.
- + Includes coffee and tea stations, a large staff cafe, an outdoor terrace, and a test kitchen.
- + Designed an integrated solution across several disciplines to achieve Tim Horton's unified approach.
- + Electrical design included power distribution provided for the new kitchen innovation lab, a relocated UPS system to the site, and a new LAN room (which supplemented four IT rooms).
- + Implemented specialty lighting across the entire space, as well as new lighting controls.
- + Designed the electronic card access control system to enhance the security of the headquarters by controlling, managing, and logging access.
- + Implemented a video intercom system, allowing visitors to interact with reception via an audio-visual experience before entering the office.
