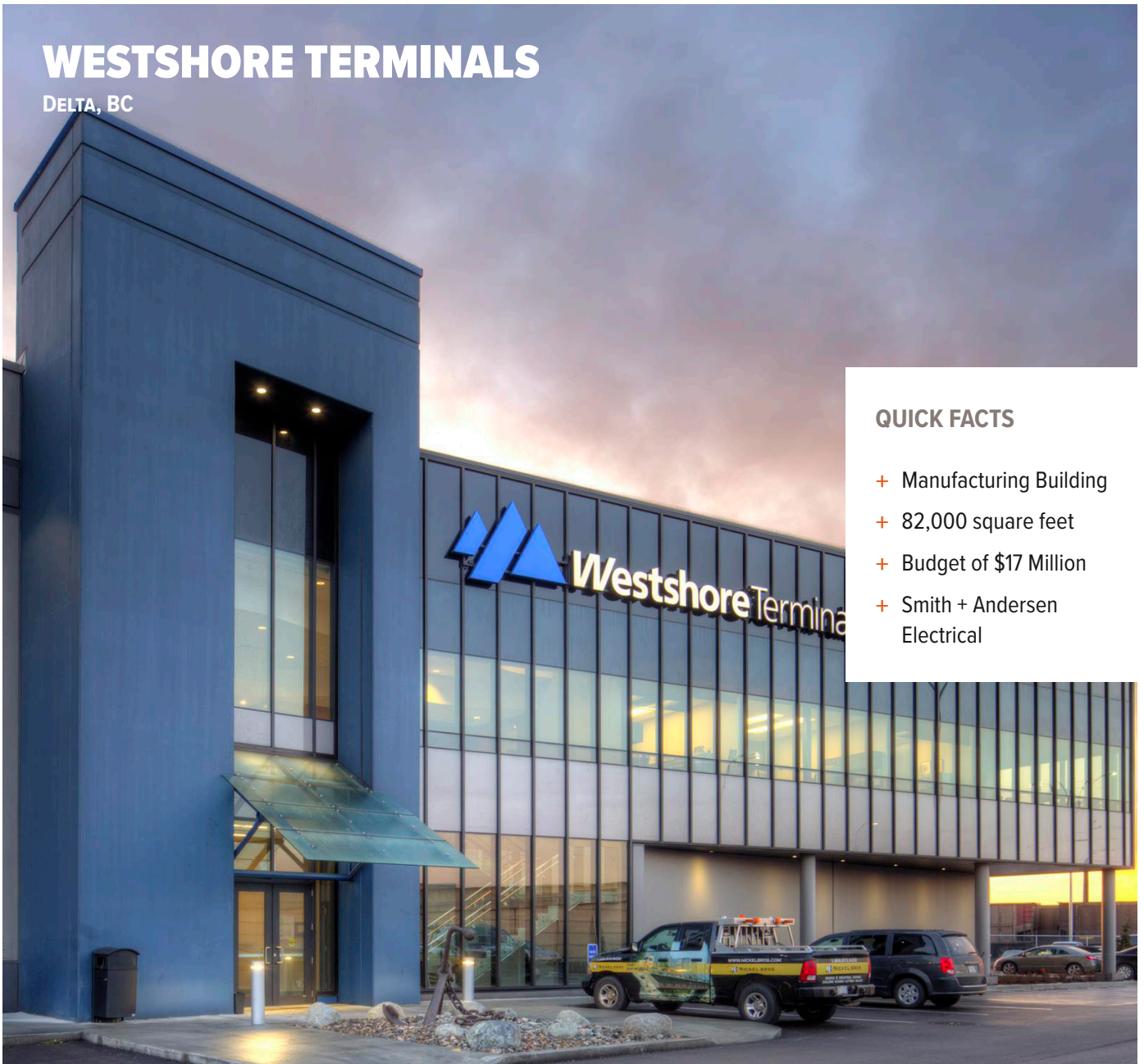

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Westshore Terminals now has an attractive yet functional base of operations in Delta.
- + Serves as the central commercial and industrial computing hub for the terminal, Westshore.
- + Smith + Andersen engaged as the electrical and communications consultant for the project.
- + Electrical scope included service provision from the existing substation on site.
- + Provided electrical distribution, process controls, and connections to accommodate heavy machinery service equipment located in the engine re-build and welding shop.
- + Required two separate server rooms - one dedicated to the commercial side and the other dedicated to the industrial side.
- + Used LED lighting throughout the facility and tied to a lighting control system, aiding in the reduction of energy use and optimization of occupant comfort.
- + Located along the Canadian border, requiring lighting quality which meets with the necessary security and surveillance standards.

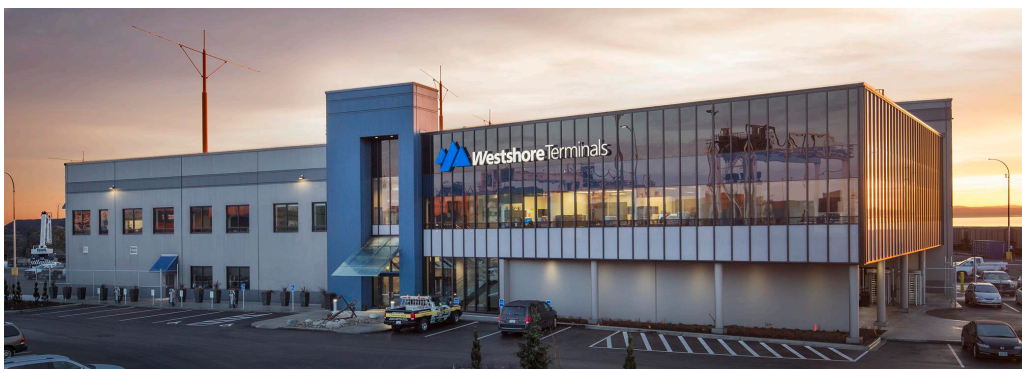
