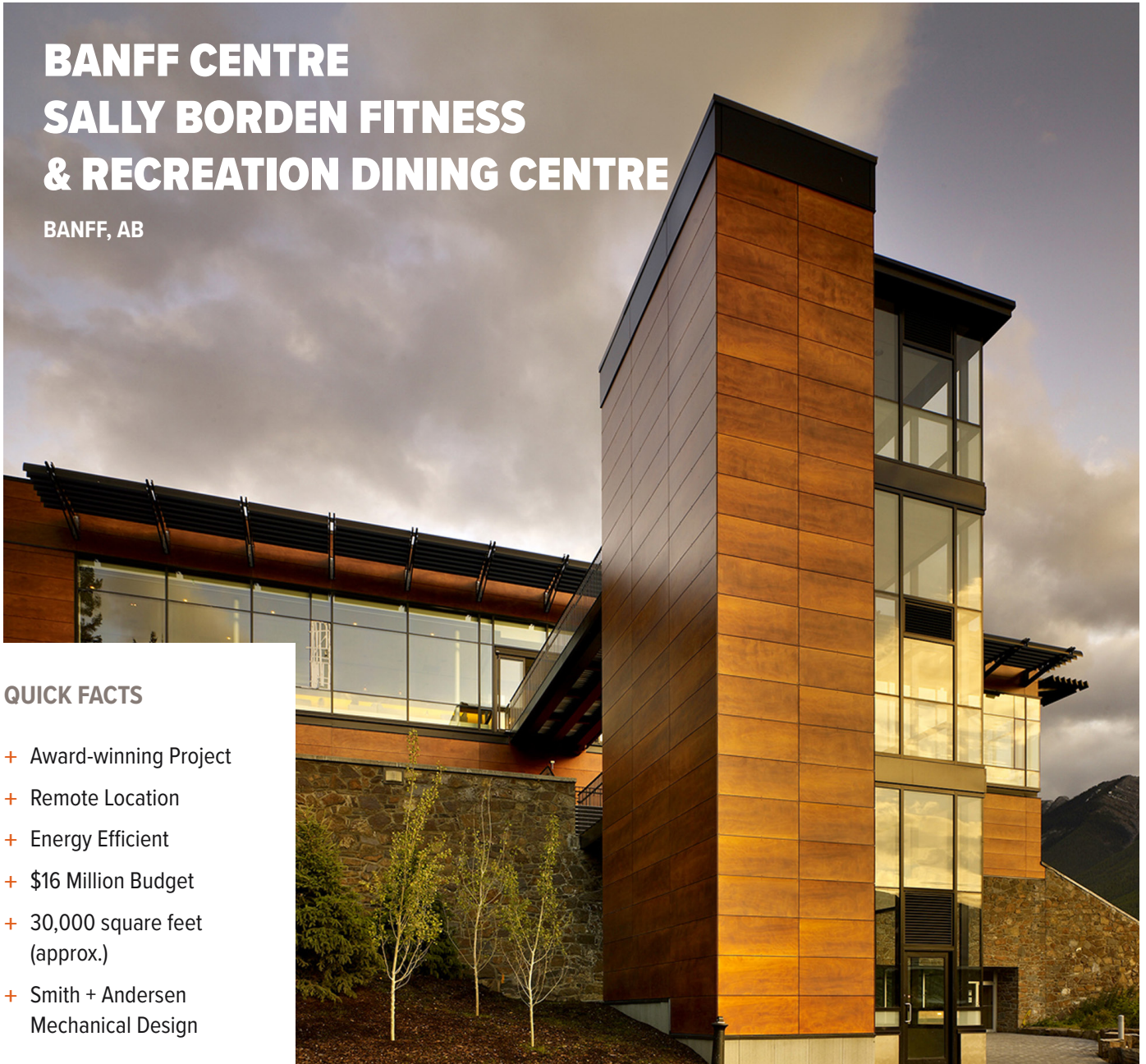

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ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Nestled in Banff National Park, the Banff Centre is an internationally recognized arts, cultural, education institution and conference facility.
- + Two-storey addition on top of the existing Sally Borden Aquatics building, featuring numerous sustainable and energy efficient strategies.
- + Includes a new dining space with a 300 seat dining room, 30 seat a la carte restaurant, and 50 seat staff dining room along with two full service kitchens, administration offices, and shipping and receiving area.
- + High efficiency boilers, demand controlled ventilation and a variable speed kitchen exhaust system enabled the facility to qualify for the Commercial Building Incentive Program (CBIP) offered by Natural Resources Canada (NRCAN).
- + Building exceeds the MNECB predicted annual building operating costs by approximately 38% for the new addition.
- + CBIP award amount was approximately \$53,000.
