## **ABOUT THIS PROJECT**

+ Fit-up for the five-storey office within the 22-storey Performance Court tower.

- + Occupies the second, third, fourth, and part of the fifth floor (includes jury rooms, boardrooms, and media listening rooms).
- + Supply air provided by compartmental units on each floor.
- + Used stealth quality fan powered boxes with hot water heating, and continuous linear diffusers for the perimeter and the same stealth quality variable air volume (VAV) boxes with a variety of air terminals, for the interior spaces.
- + Maintained the low noise criteria (a client priority).
- + Exposed ceilings found throughout most of the space required extensive coordination to creatively disguise equipment to maintain an aesthetically pleasing space.
- + Multiple jury rooms with video linking capabilities required additional measures to achieve the low noise criteria.
- + Required exposed ceiling installation and coordination to install the electrical systems.
- + Installed occupancy controlled lighting, and integrated the digital metering system with the base building system to monitor power consumption.
