+ High-performance aquatics and athletics facility constructed on the University of Toronto Scarborough Campus for the Toronto 2015 Pan Am & Parapan American Games.

- + Students, high performance athletes, sporting groups, and community residents of all ages have facilities available to them such as gymnasia and multipurpose program areas to fitness and training facilities.
- + Designed the structured cabling system to support the building voice, data, and wireless network.
- + Design encompassed standards from three different building legacy stakeholders along with provisions for the support and broadcast of the games.
- + Designed a complete security system including access control and video surveillance system to meet the legacy stakeholders operational standards.
