ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Provides a four-season overnight shelter for backcountry hikers and skiers near Russet Lake on the Spearhead Traverse.
- + Accommodates up to 38 travellers and four custodians.
- + Includes beds, storage areas for travel equipment, dining areas, and kitchens with propane cook tops.
- + Highly-sustainable facility funded through public fundraising, with volunteers providing the majority of the labour.
- + Engaged as mechanical and electrical consultants for the first hut.
- + Provided composting toilets, propane heaters, and a grey-water dispersion system to divert waste water to a dedicated septic field.
- + Solar panels with a back-up propane generator provides electricity to the facility.
