





ABBOTSFORD LAW COURTS

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Four-storey courthouse within the City Centre Civic Precinct, featuring 14 rooms and three Supreme Court courtrooms, eight Provincial Court courtrooms, and three judicial conference rooms.
- + Includes programs such as Crown counsel, community corrections, and a Justice Access Centre, as well as a parkade.
- + Mechanical design included six indoor air handling units, which serve the facility's courtrooms, court administration rooms, judges' chambers, holding areas, and public circulation spaces.
- + Special consideration given to the system's redundancy and isolation of the various air streams to eliminate the risk of contaminating secure areas.
- + Cooling provided through the use of three air-cooled chillers, and heated with three natural gas-fired condensing boilers.
- + Provided protection of sensitive exhibits and evidence storage areas through installed clean agent fire protection systems.
- + Incorporated modern integrated systems that support secure networks for a diverse user group, including security and building automation systems for judicial and public rooms.
- + Electrical design included a single-ended unit substation and generator, with N+1 UPS power for life safety and backup power.
