# **ABOUT THIS PROJECT**

- + Part of the Calgary TELUS Convention Centre, in downtown Calgary, this large, basement-level venue serves as both a pre-function and event space.
- + Moveable walls allow it to be used as one large area or broken into smaller spaces.
- + Features ceiling installation inspired by Alberta's natural landscapes, which runs the length of the pre-function space.
- + Lighting design utilized colour-changing linear LEDs placed perpendicular to curved fins on the ceiling to highlight the feature ceiling.
- + Customizable recessed colour-changing liner lights were installed on the columns that line the space.
- + White pendant lights interspersed among the ceiling slats provide downlight for general illumination.
- + Wall wash luminaries are used in seating zones and other amenities important for the comfort of guests, as well as to draw attention to artworks in these areas.
- + Downlights were placed to accommodate existing connections in the drywall.
- + Lighting control system allows every aspect of lighting to be controlled individually by the client so each function can cultivate its own creativity and mood.
- + Mechanical project scope consisted of a washroom renovation.
