

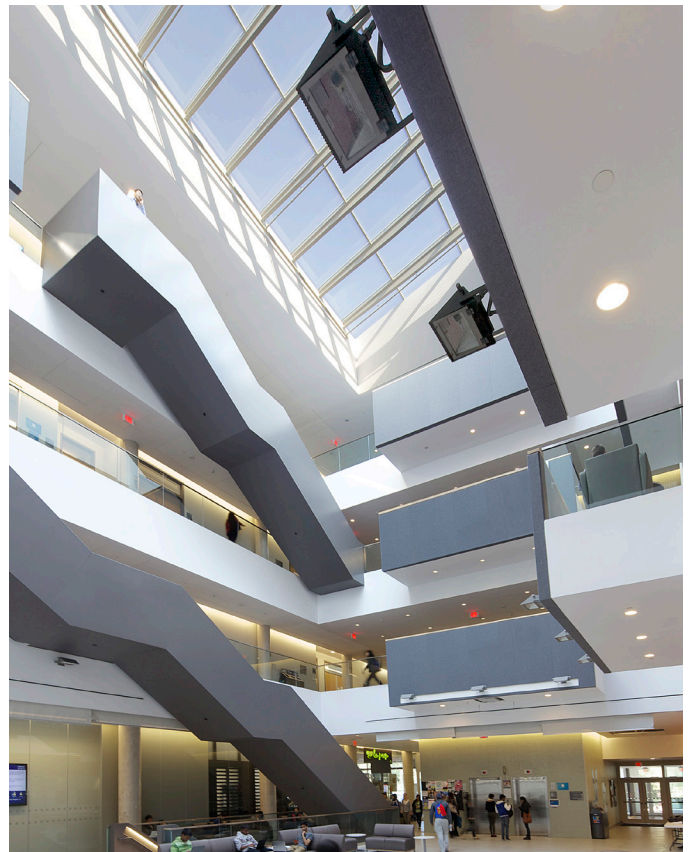
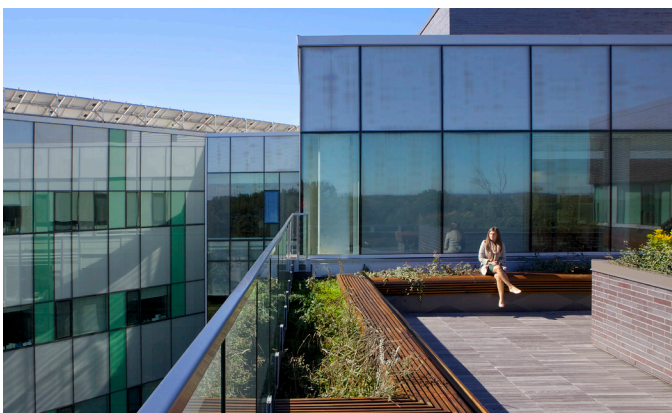

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Increased University of Toronto Scarborough's (UTSC) academic space on campus by 25 per cent.
- + Four-storey facility includes computer labs, six full-sized classrooms, a street-front coffee shop, a restaurant, two large lecture halls, capable of seating 350 and 120, and four smaller 80 seat lecture spaces.
- + Features a four-storey skylight atrium, exterior balconies, a rooftop garden, courtyard, and a glass bridge (all to bring natural light into the building and highlight views of the surrounding landscape).
- + Improved sustainability through providing heat recovery on the building ventilation systems, demand control ventilation, and photovoltaic panels for on site power generation.
