

MILTON DISTRICT HOSPITAL EXPANSION

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Construction of a diagnostic, therapeutic, and inpatient building (interfaces with the existing Milton District Hospital building via a service tunnel and walkway).
- + Includes approximately 66 additional inpatient beds, as well as: emergency, security and surgical services, inpatient medical / surgical units, critical care, maternal newborn,and new diagnostic imaging services including the hospital's first MRI machine.
- + Renovated the existing hospital to accommodate the service tunnel and walkway (required the design and construction team to work closely with the clinical staff and facility managers to achieve minimal disruption to the existing hospital operation).
- Mechanical systems include a condensing dual fuel boiler plant, high efficiency chilled water plant (with air and water side energy recovery), and low-flow plumbing fixtures for reduced water consumption.
- + Arranged the plant to provide N+1 redundancy to meet the peak building load with the largest piece of equipment out of service.
- To minimize the risk of interruption from the hospital's ICT infrastructure, a "mission critical" mechanical and electrical design features a highly redundant and available 2N system.
