

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ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Project consists of 312-bed residence (single and double dormitory rooms) on four levels, plus a partial basement for undergraduate students.
- + Amenities include lounges, study rooms, shared washrooms, and laundry facilities.
- + A large dining room and full service kitchen on the ground floor can accommodate up to 400 students (and also serves students from surrounding residences).
- + The facility is supported mechanically by a hybrid heat pump system with a closed loop fluid cooler.
- + The central heating plant consists of condensing boilers for high efficiency heating throughout.
- + Electrically, emergency lighting is supported from a central batter storage system.
- + This project was constructed as part of the Government of Ontario Education Grant program and delivered as a fast paced Construction Management program.
