## **ABOUT THIS PROJECT**

**LOCATION**Brantford, ON

Retained to provide the next stages of construction administration following the design phases (included the "close-out" of Phase 1 and the full construction administration of Phase 2). The Engineer-of-Record remained as the original design engineer for the project.

+ Phase 1 included a new four-pad arena, new change rooms, a restaurant and pro shop, multi-purpose rooms, a gymnasium, and an indoor running track.

SIZE

240,000 sq. ft. (22,296 sq. m.)

+ Phase 2 included an aquatic centre with a 25-metre pool, a therapy pool, a fitness and dry land training centre, change rooms, aerobics, weight lifting spaces, and a Wellness Centre.

**BUDGET** \$50 Million

- + The backbone of the mechanical design is a heat pump system with a combination of central air handlers (heat pumps) and local, space-mounted heat pumps to serve the heating and cooling requirements.
- + Heat recovery make-up air handlers provide outdoor air (for ventilation).
- + Heat is reclaimed from the refrigerant systems that create the ice in the rinks and is used in the domestic hot water and heat pump loop if required.
- + Dehumidification air handlers are utilized in the aquatics centre and desiccant air handlers are utilized in the ice rinks.
