ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Provides medical outpatient clinics, clinical and administrative support, education and research space, and outpatient mental health programs to the citizens of Brampton.
- + Programs accommodated at the centre include an extended care centre with an ambulatory procedure clinic housing eight surgical suites, a new dialysis unit, diagnostic imaging services, a day surgery facility, chronic disease prevention clinics, seniors' wellness programs, and comprehensive care for women / children / teens.
- + Targeted LEED Silver but achieved LEED Gold certification.
- + Three-storey atrium space opens into an entrance plaza through the lobby space to one of several courtyards.
- + Project features a geothermal field, along with heat recovery chillers, condensing boilers, and a very low pressure drop air handling system (using oversized air handlers and oversized ductwork).
- + Chiller plant consists of magnetic bearing chillers and geothermal heat pump chillers (which is used to generate heating water for the building).
- + Geothermal chillers are used to store heat in the ground through the geothermal loops to be used at an appropriate time, as determined by the building automation system.
- + Heating plant consists of condensing hydronic boilers and heat from the geothermal heat pump chillers to feed low-water temperature heating loops.
