ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + 300-bed long-term care facility located along Yukon River (north-end of Whitehorse).
- + Engaged on Phase 1 of the project, which included a new 150-bed building providing palliative and mental health care.
- + At full build-out, the project will also include full kitchen and laundry facilities.
- + Variety of uses included in Phase 1 necessitated a new data centre, as well as dedicated mechanical and electrical rooms to support uninterrupted operations.
- + Due to location of site, availability of electrical and mechanical services was a priority.
- + Enhanced coordination between all systems facilitates the interoperability required to support the facility's operational work flows throughout the building.
- + Electrical systems designed with multiple levels of redundancy.
- + Systems include redundant power delivery paths, redundant 600 voltage synchronized generators setup to parallel with utility source (complete with load bank and varying degrees of load shedding), N+1 UPS system configuration, and a two-stage fire alarm system.
- + Infrastructure design supports several systems on a common network with multiple virtual local area networks (VLAN) including systems such as: nurse call, security, metering, monitoring, building control, a real-time locating system (RTLS), and wired and wireless data and voice systems.
