ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Mechanical, electrical, and specialty lighting designers worked collaboratively to provide upgrade and design recommendations for the historical church.
- + Upper level archways are each painted with a narrow beam of light, achieved through up-lights from two fixtures under each arch that distribute light at 180-degree angles.
- + Lighting upgrades maintain the traditional church-feel with adjustable light levels that give the place of worship an ambient glow and refurbishing heritage pendants.
- + Designers took not only aesthetics into account but also practical functions of the church like accommodating reading light levels.
- + Altar is illuminated in a manner that minimizes glare for the speaker at the front and the public sitting in pews.
- + Luminaries create focal points within the space highlighting features like the pulpit and the organ.
